Please be aware that although the Alberta Dental Association and College (ADA & C) publishes a Fee Guide, offices in Alberta are not obligated to follow any or all published fees within that Guide. Each dental office is responsible for determining the costs associated with providing the quality of care each patient has come to expect from their dental providers.

Each insurance company assigns their own fee guide to the policy in effect. The fee's contained in this assigned guide are often referred to as the eligible expense of an associated service code and may or may not match the ADA or an office's fee guide.
